I have finally purchased the Arbortech AS160 Allsaw after almost, dare i say it, a years deliberation. The outcome; wish I had bought one sooner.

The first job in hand was to replace 15 damaged stones from the gable end of a 250 year old cottage.

Years of weather damage, poor cementitious pointing and internal smoke damage had taken its toll on the stonework.

Normal procedure to remove the damaged stones would have been to carefully drill and chisel away the existing mortar, however by using the Arbortech with the plunge blade and cutting around the stones they came out like a dream.

What would have taken maybe a week to complete was done in 3 days. So the Arbortech has paid for itself in its first job alone!


Next job is several individual brick replacements in a 17th century rectory. Should be a doddle with my new piece of kit.
