



## UNLEASH YOUR CREATIVITY

### Celtic Knot Wall Art

**TOOLS REQUIRED:** Arbortech Power Chisel, Deep V Chisel, Small Flat Chisel, MDF Board, Clamping Device, Acrylic Paints



#### Step One

Cut a piece of 9 –12mm thick MDF board to required size (this can vary according to your frame or size of art piece you want to create).



#### Step Two

Lay some carbon paper over the board then place the paper design on top.

Fix the design firmly in place using tape, and trace on your design.

### Step Three

Securely clamp your work piece. Using the V chisel (pch.fg.002), carefully follow the pattern making sure that you don't cross over the continuous lines.

Once you are happy with your lines using the V Chisel, change to a small flat chisel for the shaping work.

### Step Four

Start shaping the under side of the knots by gently chiseling with the small flat chisel approx 12mm or 1/2" from each solid line, this will give the illusion the knots going under each other. After chiseling all the under knots make sure edges are tidy.



### Step Five

Then give the whole piece a light sanding with fine sandpaper giving focus to the chiseled under knots to ensure they are clean and smooth ready for painting or varnish.

### Step Six

Now you either put a clear lacquer finish on your work piece or paint with acrylic paints. If using two colours, paint the background colour first, wait until dry then carefully paint the knots with a contrast colour.

Once dry, your workpiece can either be mounted and framed, or left as is and hung.
